<b>Buddy Bench</b>	Anne Sullivan	RCMS	Purchase a colorful and inviting bench to be placed in Middle School recess area.	Allows students to have a place to go during recess. Coordinate an effort for HS woodworking class to create additional benches for other Elementary Schools.
<b>Research Text Sets</b>	4 <sup>th</sup> Grade Districtwide	All 4th Grades	Purchase texts related to the science unit for 4 <sup>th</sup> Graders that were missed at the beginning of the school year	Worthwhile investment in quality non-fiction texts for science research.
<b>Math Manipulation</b>	Frank McCourt	Young Elementary	Purchase math manipulatives for 2 <sup>nd</sup> Grade math learners.	Manipulatives are useful tools to help students understand math concepts.
<b>Audiobooks</b>	Gilderoy Lockhart & Poppy Pomfrey	Donovan Elementary	A variety of audiobooks to give 5 <sup>th</sup> graders an opportunity to read books which are above their reading level.	Audiobooks enrich a child's multisensory experience with books and promote valuable listening skills.

<b>Blended Learning</b>	Edna Krabappel	RHS	Purchase 2 @ iPad Airs and 2 licenses to the Doceri application for Math Dept. to share.	Technology will help Math Dept. to incorporate hybrid learning approach with students learning face-to-face and online.
<b>Soar to Success: STEM Materials</b>	Elizabeth Halsey and Dewey Finn	Lyons Elementary	STEM materials for 1 <sup>st</sup> Grade classrooms to help them plan, design, test, and reassess their products until they meet their expectations.
